

V2V FAQs

- Q. I didn't get my package yet. Can I pick one up?
- R. Yes. Extra packages can be picked up in the church lobby or at the church office.
- Q. Can additional packages be sent to my friends and family?
- R. If your friends or family are interested in the Vision to Victory campaign, please have them review the information on-line at www.fcpcb.org. If after reviewing the information they decide they want to participate, please have them call the church at 910.259.3046 and a complete package will be sent to them.
- Q. I keep hearing that we need to contribute \$40 per week. I can't afford to contribute \$40 a week. Why is the church asking for this amount?
- R. FCBC is convinced that if everyone does their part and follows how God is leading them, that we can meet our needs of \$694,000. The \$40 a week is an example based on 115 families contributing \$40 weekly for 3 years (or 156 weeks). It is just an example to show that we can raise the money. With more than 115 families attending our church we would hope that those who can give more will give what they can. And for those who cannot give \$40 weekly that they will give all that they can. The key is sacrifice. Not equal gifts, but equal sacrifice.
- Q. I am concerned about making a commitment now that I might not be able to keep for 3 years. The economy is so uncertain. How should I handle my decision?
- R. We only ask that you pray about your decision and give what the Lord prompts you to give now. How much you give or if you need to change your amount is between you and the Lord. Keep in prayer about your decision.
- Q. Who sees how much I am contributing?
- R. Access is restricted to only those who need to know for accounting purposes. We are taking all necessary steps to guard your confidentiality.
- Q. I don't want to be singled out as giving too little. Will anyone know how much I am committing to on Commitment Sunday (Sept. 12th)?
- R. No. Everyone has the same envelope. No one in the congregation will be able to tell how much you are committing to give. Please seal the envelope and join the congregation on committing to this special project.

- Q. I won't be there on Commitment Sunday (Sept. 12th). Can I hand in my card earlier or later?
- R. We are asking everyone to hand in their commitment card on or before September 12th. If you can not attend church on Sept. 12, please mail or drop off your sealed envelope to the church office.
- Q. How do I send in my contributions? Do I include it in my tithe check? Do I need to write a separate check? How often do I need to write a check? Can I make one lump sum payment for each year or even one for the 3 year period?
- R. You can hand in your Vision 2 Victory (V2V) contributions in the offering plate. To ensure accurate accounting we would prefer a separate check than your tithe check. However, you can write one check instead. If you write one check, make sure you clearly note the amount for V2V in the subject line AND on the outside of the envelope (if you used one). The current envelopes have a notation for Building Fund. You can use that selection until we get new envelopes printed with a selection for V2V. It is up to you how you want to manage your contributions. You can write a check every year, one check to cover the three years, or hand in checks weekly or monthly. It really is up to you.
- Q. How will we get updates on the project's status?
- R. We are still working on the details, but we plan to have monthly announcements and visual aids showings how we are tracking against goal.
- Q. Why are we waiting 3 years to start the building?
- R. We actually want to begin construction at the end of the 2nd year or at the latest at the beginning of the 3rd year. Our goal is to have the building built and paid for by 36 months.
- Q. Who should I contact if I still have questions?
